Artist Profile

Rita Carpio



Rita Maria Carpio was born into a musical family. In 1982, Rita entered the inaugural New Talent Singing Awards International Finals in Hong Kong and garnered the first runner-up title in the competition. During the 1980s, Rita recorded music albums in both English and Cantonese. Her popularity rose in the late 80s through the 90s. In 1990, her duet with Ram Chiang, *No Need to Know One Another*, was a top ten winner at the 13th Top Ten Chinese Gold Songs Award in Hong Kong. This and many of her other popular tunes, including *Kneeling at the Door*, have joined the list of classic Cantonese pop songs.

In 2014, at the invitation of Television Broadcasts Limited (TVB) and Ram Chiang, Rita joined the cast of Come On, Cousin, a popular TVB comedy series in Hong Kong. Her role in the series commanded rave reviews and brought Rita's popularity back into the limelight.
