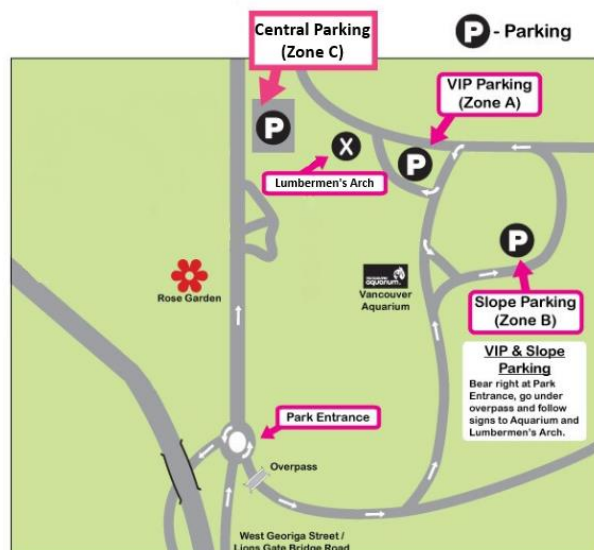
Free Shuttle Buses

No registration or ticket required.

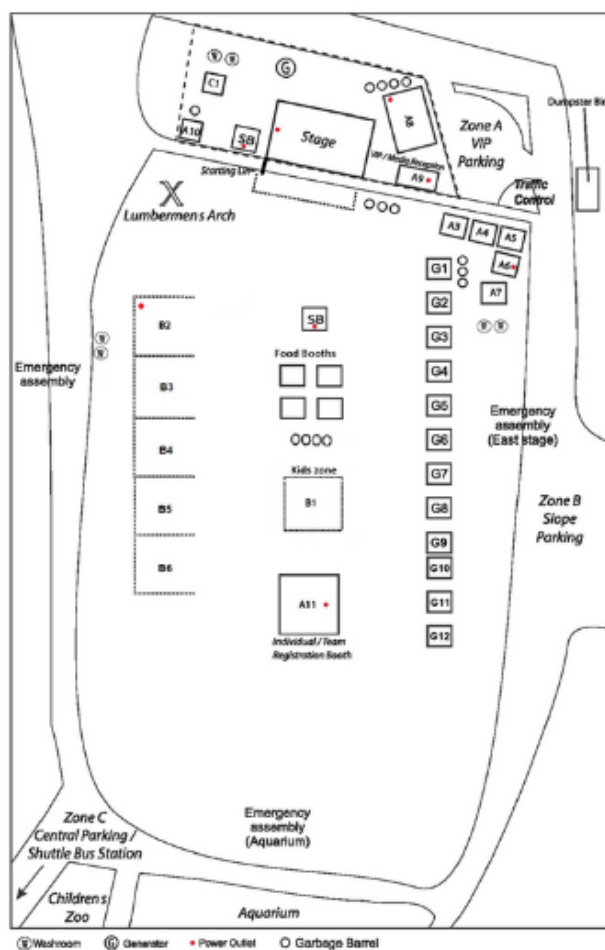
